## **Consumer Health Data Privacy Notice**

We may share your health data with parties administering the study, trial or offering a product that is being used in such an activity, agencies that regulate our products (including the Food and Drug Administration, the "FDA"), in conjunction with our obligations to report Adverse Experiences to the FDA.

If you are a consumer in a state with laws specifically offering you privacy rights over your health data, subject to certain exceptions, you may have certain rights related to your health data, including rights to confirm processing and access, delete, or withdraw consent relating to such health data.
